What is KODI?

Kodi is a free, open-source media player and entertainment hub that lets you play and stream a wide variety of digital media, including:

Movies

TV shows

Music

Photos

Live TV and radio (with proper setup)

Originally known as XBMC (Xbox Media Center), Kodi was first developed for the original Xbox but has since evolved into a versatile media platform that runs on nearly all major operating systems, including:

Windows

macOS

Linux

Android

iOS (with some extra steps)

Raspberry Pi

Key Features:

Customizable interface with skins and themes

Add-ons and plug-ins: Thousands are available to expand its functionality, including weather, streaming services, and utilities

Supports many file formats: MP4, MKV, MP3, FLAC, etc.

Network streaming: Stream from local or network storage, or over the internet

PVR (Personal Video Recorder) support for live TV and DVR features

Important Note:

Kodi itself is legal, but some third-party add-ons can give access to pirated content, which may be illegal depending on your region. Always be cautious about what add-ons you install.

What is a VPN?

A **VPN** (Virtual Private Network) is a service that helps protect your online privacy and security by creating a **private, encrypted connection** between your device and the internet.

Here's a breakdown of what that means:

What does a VPN do?

- 1. Encrypts your internet traffic**
 - This means no one (like hackers, your internet service provider, or even the government) can see what you're doing online.
- 2. Masks your IP address**
 - It hides your real location by routing your traffic through a server in a different city or country. So websites see the VPN server's IP, not yours.
- 3. Bypasses censorship or geo-restrictions**
 - You can access content that might be blocked in your country (like certain Netflix libraries, websites, or apps).

4. **Secures public Wi-Fi**

- Using a VPN on public Wi-Fi (like in cafes or airports) helps protect you from people trying to snoop on your connection.

Example:

Without a VPN: You → Internet → Websites see your real IP + location

With a VPN:

You → Encrypted tunnel → VPN server → Internet → Websites see VPN's IP + not your real one


Once you have a VPN Go to Kodi website and download on your machine.


With Xbox go to Microsoft Store

Scroll Down to System Settings





Go to Add Ons




Scroll Right and Down to Unknown Sources and hit enter then scroll left hit yes


Hit Back and scroll up to File Manager



Hit Enter Scroll Down to Add Source




Hit enter It will take you to this screen below where you will hit enter again


Hit Okay if media source is complete and correct. Then hit okay again It should be right there as below




Hit back again to settings menu and click add on Add Ons



Scroll Down to Install from zip file and hit enter




Scroll down to diggzreo file hit enter and then scroll to zip file hit enter




The Chef Wizard will come up on screen like below click back




Scroll up from to Click on Install from Repository




Scroll Down to diggzrepo and hit enter then scroll down to program add Ons




Hit Enter Scroll to Chief Omega Wizard




Hit Enter and Install




Hit okay once then for other add on and it will start to download once it hits a 100% you
May have to hit enter or it may automatically come up like this screen may come up below




Hit Enter and that will disappear and then this will come up immediately




Click left to yes and hit enter then scroll down to Diggz Debrid I will be going over real debrid service at the end.




Hit Enter

Then this will come up hit enter and close Kodi









Scroll Down one and left to Chef Wizard






Click enter and scroll down to authorize debrid and trakt and hit enter



It will take you to this screen hit on step 1 install Supported add ons




It will take you to next menu and it is your choice to begin setting up some default features within the build.

Don't worry — if you accidentally exit or skip a step, you can always return to **Chef Wizard** from the Add-ons section later.




After last page hit back to the first menu



Click right on Set Up Wizard to Install Xenon Skin




Hit enter and scroll left to yes hit enter
